Instructions to Applicant: You may enter online at www.gon.com.

• BEFORE the deer is caped or skinned, have digital photos taken of you and your buck. Digital photos may be sent on a CD or entered online at www.gon.com. **Deer that are caped or skinned before photos are taken are not eligible for entry.** Digital photos should be at least 1 megabyte in size. Your photo may appear in **GON**, so take the time to get quality shots. Poor photos will not be published.

• On a separate sheet of paper, write a description of your hunt.

• Read the rules of the Truck-Buck contest. Then sign and date this entry form at the bottom.

• Along with this Official Entry Form and the written hunt story, mail at least three of your favorite photos of you with the deer. **GON** cannot return these photos. The entire entry must be received by **GON** within seven (7) business days of the date the buck was killed. We strongly recommend next-day priority mail or online entry. A missed deadline means the buck is disqualified from the contest.

• Remove or have your taxidermist remove the rack so that only the antlers attached to the skull plate remain. Do not mount, pin or brace the rack for any reason. Do not soak or submerge the rack in any solution. Do not freeze the rack except as may be necessary for a day or two until the rack, head and cape can be taken to a taxidermist. Allow the rack to air-dry naturally.

• Do not have the rack scored by an official Boone & Crockett or Pope & Young measurer prior to the official contest scoring day without **GON** approval.

• Follow the contest coverage in future issues of **GON** to learn the date, time and location of the official contest scoring event. Bring only the intact rack (antlers and skull plate) to the official scoring event. Only racks that are properly entered and brought to the official scoring event are eligible to compete in the Truck-Buck contest.

• Be careful with the rack. **GON** cannot score a broken rack or a rack with a cracked or broken skull plate.

I hereby affirm that this buck was taken by legal means and that no state laws or rules of the **GON** Truck-Buck contest were violated. I agree that if I win a scoring period or wildcard division that I will appear and take a polygraph test at a time and location to be determined by **GON**, and I agree that my failure to take or pass the polygraph test will result in my disqualification from the Truck-Buck contest.

Have Quality Photos Taken:

- Select an uncluttered background.
- Hold the rack in a way that doesn't hide points or parts of the antlers.
- Have the photographer take each shot at a different angle and distance (no closer than 6 feet, no farther than 15).
- The sun should be shining in your face and on the photographer's back.
- Use a flash in low-light conditions.
- Tuck in or hide the buck's tongue.
